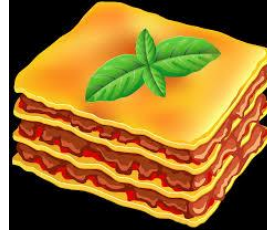
### Birch Hills Senior Center Memberships
