

A Bylaw of Birch Hills County, in the Province of Alberta, for the purpose of closing and leasing the whole or a portion of a public roadway.

WHEREAS: The Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, c. M-26 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and amendments thereto, provides that Council may, with the approval of the Minister of Transportation, pass bylaws for the purpose of closing the whole or any portion of any road; and

WHEREAS: the lands herein described are no longer required for public travel and the Council for Birch Hills County considers it necessary to close and lease the road;

WHEREAS: notice of the County's intention to close and lease the public highway described herein has been published in the local newspaper, on March 6, 2018 and March 13, 2018 the last date of publication being at least fourteen (14) days before the date fixed for the passing of this Bylaw;

AND WHEREAS: Council provided the opportunity for any person prejudicially affected by the bylaw to be heard and recorded at a Public Hearing held on March 29, 2018.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Council for Birch Hills County, duly assembled, does hereby close to public travel and lease the public highway described as follows and shown in Schedule "A", which schedule is attached and forms part of this Bylaw, subject to the rights of access granted by other legislation.

1. Subject to the approval of the Minister of Transportation,

All of that portion of statutory road allowance that borders the east boundary of the east half section of eleven (11), township seventy-six (76), range four (4), west of the sixth (6th) meridian.

and

All of that portion of statutory road allowance which forms the east boundary of the south east quarter section of fourteen (14), township seventy-six (76), range four (4), west of the sixth (6^{th}) meridian.




Schedule A

All that portion of road allowance that borders:

 The east boundary of the east half section of eleven (11), township seventy-six (76), range four (4), west of the sixth (6th) meridian.

and

 The east boundary of the south east quarter section of fourteen (14), township seventy-six (76), range four (4), west of the sixth (6th) meridian.
