



BYLAW NO. 2020-06

A BYLAW OF BIRCH HILLS COUNTY TO ESTABLISH A POSITION OF A DESIGNATED OFFICER AS THE COUNTY ASSESSOR.

- PURPOSE** A Bylaw of Birch Hills County, in the Province of Alberta, to appoint an Assessor as a Designated Officer;
- WHEREAS** Section 210 of the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26, outlines the appointment of Designated Officers;
- WHEREAS** Section 284 of the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26, requires that Council must appoint an Assessor as a Designated Officer;
- NOW THEREFORE** the Council for Birch Hills County in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:
1. This Bylaw may be cited as the "County Assessor Bylaw"
 2. A Designated Officer position of a County Assessor is hereby established.
 3. That Rod Guttinger be appointed as a Designated Officer of Birch Hills County.
 4. That Rod Guttinger, as a Designated Officer, carries out the duties of Assessor as outlined under Parts 9, 10, 11 and 12 of the Municipal Government Act.
 5. That Rod Guttinger shall be deemed to be an Independent Contractor and not an employee of Birch Hills County.
 6. That Bylaw No. 2013-03 is hereby rescinded.

This Bylaw shall come into effect the date of the final passage thereof.
