



BYLAW NO. 2019-13

COUNTY OF GRANDE PRAIRIE NO. 1 **INTERMUNICIPAL COLLABORATION FRAMEWORK BYLAW**

- PURPOSE:** Section 708.28(1) of the *Municipal Government Act*, being Chapter M-26 of the Statutes of Alberta, as amended, mandates that municipalities that have common boundaries must create an Intermunicipal Collaboration Framework with each other that identifies the services provided by each County, which services are best provided on an intermunicipal basis, and how services to be provided on an intermunicipal basis will be delivered and funded;
- WHEREAS** Birch Hills County and the County of Grande Prairie No. 1 share a common border;
- WHEREAS** Birch Hills County and the County of Grande Prairie No. 1 share common interest and are desirous of working together to provide services to their residents;
- AND WHEREAS** Birch Hills County and the County of Grande Prairie No. 1 consulted with residents of both Counties;
- NOW THEREFORE** The Birch Hill County Council, in the Province of Alberta, adopts the Birch Hills County / the County of Grande Prairie No. 1 Intermunicipal Collaboration Framework, being the document attached hereto and forming part of this Bylaw.
- AND THEREFORE** By-law No. 2019-13 come into force and effect on the final date of passing thereof.
